

Parkinson's Disease Research Studies Seeking Participants in Northeast Ohio

Great Lakes NeuroTechnologies Inc. (GLNT) is seeking individuals with Parkinson's disease (PD) to participate in a data collection research study that will help to improve a PD home monitoring system. The system is designed to capture changes in PD symptoms and medication side-effects throughout the day in response to medication. This would provide doctors and researchers with more information about how symptoms are affected by treatments and may allow doctors to better tailor treatment interventions in response to these changes.



This is a data collection study only, no treatment will be provided. For about one minute of every hour, participants will wear a small, lightweight, noninvasive motion sensor on the finger while completing three tasks that are part of a typical PD motor assessment. Participants will also complete a multiple choice diary about how they feel. Data collection will take place wherever the participant goes for two consecutive days during each of four consecutive weeks. At the conclusion of the study participants will be asked to complete a questionnaire about their experiences with the system.
